- 1 The applicant claims the site is not visible. I would point out that the site is highly visible from Moditonham Quay where the road meets the river. A local beauty spot with seating, much visited and appreciated by locals. The area is designated an ANOB and a SSSI. It is visible over a radius of over 180 degrees from the Tamar to Kingsmill Lake.
- 2 The farm currently pollutes Kingsmill Lake and impacts on the waders food source. This is clearly visible as the resulting algae bloom is avoided by the birds, thus restricting the feeding area. Considering that this is tidal the impact on the food available is considerable. Recently the farm installed a large diameter drain pipe which has made the problem more visible. The flow foams and smells down the lake so is not simply rain water.
- 3 It is placed in a separate field from the main farm buildings meaning field pattern changes, loss of open space and hedges needing to be removed for access.
- 4 The farm is far too large and intensive for the highly sensitive location. It is reached via tiny country lanes past a school that children need to cross and requires extremely large HGV lorries delivering feed and bedding every day already. Several weeks of the year are intolerable in the lanes when the farm is doing muck spreading or harvesting with many contractor drivers filling the lanes for up to 14 hours a day. The roads around the area especially at the junction to the farm are badly damaged by the heavy traffic and the hedges, bridges and walls of the parish are often damaged by the contractors' tractors and trailers.
