Dear Parish Council

I write in the hope that you may be able to assist in resolving an issue arising in the parish and that need urgent attention.

Due to the roadworks occurring on the A388 drivers are (now routinely) choosing to divert or rat run through Botus Fleming a single carriageway rural lane with a few passing places. This country lane is not suitable as a substitute for the A388 and this level of traffic is entirely unsustainable for this location. This diversion by drivers results in long queues of cars from each way creating a log jam in the village where it narrows on the road from

Moditonham to Spindleberry. There is only one adequate passing place on this stretch of road, it is entirely unsuited for this level of traffic and something needs to be done urgently to address this issue.

- 1. The roadworks need to be better managed to avoid the extensive queues causing drivers to seek alternative options.
- 2. Drivers need to be prevented from using Botus Fleming as a cut through from Hatt to Carkeel in order to avoid traffic.

This is also a road safety issue as the lanes are used extensively by walkers and also by horse riders and due to the limited areas to pass are unable to avoid the traffic.

I look forward to hearing from you as to how you might assist in resolving the issue.
