#### 1255/2023 Chair's Welcome & Announcements

Cllr Willey (Vice Chairman) deputising for Cllr Edwards (Chairman) welcomed residents to the Public Meeting of the Parish Council and delivered Health and Safety housekeeping rules.

#### 1256 Presentation & Public participation

Steve Malcolm (resident) informed the Meeting that he had been successful in securing funding of £2,500 under the Annual Award scheme by (AVIVA) Mid Cornwall Brokers. The bid for £2,500 had been successful and was ranked nationally as number 30 out of 116. Grant monies would be received soon and would be spent on installing playground fencing at the Recreation Field.

The Parish Council agreed to provide (AVIVA) with a progress report in connection with the playground fencing.

The Parish Council thanked Steve Malcolm for the time and effort spent in securing grant monies and for continued grant work including match-funding initiatives with the crowdfunding project in Newquay.

A Cllr Sally White - Maintenance

Cllr. **B** Cllr Malcolm Fletcher – Climate and Ecological Emergency

Cllr. Fletcher has reported to Cormac highways regarding the ash dieback disease noted in a few trees in the woodland area opposite the Elms and Hatt House

Tree planting along the A388 verge would commence in late November with residents invited to bring along their saplings and baby trees.

**C** Cllr Mervyn Ellis – BOTHER

Cllr Fletcher referred to the information being dealt with as reported at item 1234 (C 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2023-

Cllr. Tagg (Landulph Parish Council) has agreed to analysis data from the Survey Monkey consultation previously carried out. The data available is somewhat limited, but Cllr Tagg is an expert in the field of data science and will make the best of the available material.

Cllr Worth confirmed that the developers of the second phase of Treledon were aware and supportive of cycle / walkways through the estate. Cllr Robinson referred to funding as already provided for these initiatives around Truro and surrounding area.

D Cllr Malcolm Fletcher – Defibrillator

Cllr Fletcher stated that the defibrillator has now been installed at the St. Mary's Hall. Thanks were expressed to Darren Doney for completing the electrical works. Training in the use of the defibrillator would be arranged as part of the Annual Lease.
